Code of Conduct for Students

1. Respect for Others

1.1 Respect for Diversity:

Students must respect the diverse backgrounds, cultures, and perspectives of their peers, teachers, and the school community, promoting an inclusive environment where everyone feels valued.

1.2 Behaviour towards Others:

Students are expected to be polite, courteous, and kind in their interactions, refraining from bullying, teasing, or any form of harassment, both in person and online.

1.3 Respect for Authority:

Students should show respect to all school staff and visitors, following instructions and responding to feedback in a respectful and cooperative manner.

2. Academic Integrity

2.1 Honesty in Work:

Students are expected to complete all assignments, tests, and examinations with honesty. Cheating, plagiarism, and any form of dishonesty are strictly prohibited.

2.2 Effort and Participation:

Students should actively participate in all classes, engage in discussions, and put forth their best effort in all academic endeavours.

2.3 Seeking Help:

Students are encouraged to seek help from teachers or peers when they do not understand something, fostering a collaborative and supportive learning environment.

3. Responsibility and Accountability

3.1 Punctuality and Attendance:

Students must arrive on time for school and classes, and attend regularly. Absences should be minimized and reported according to school procedures.

3.2 Completion of Assignments:

Students are responsible for completing all homework, projects, and other assignments on time. Failure to do so without a valid reason may result in consequences as outlined by the school.

3.3 Ownership of Actions:

Students should take responsibility for their actions, admitting mistakes and learning from them. Blaming others or making excuses is discouraged.
